Layout

- Length: Min. 4 pages max. 8 pages (including tables, pictures, graphs and references)
- Page size: DIN A4 (210 x 297 mm)
- Type area: Should not exceed 160 x 250 mm
- Font: Arial (12pt)
- First page: Must start with a box containing the title of your work, the name(s) of the author(s) and the affiliations given. This box must have the diameters 65 x 160 mm.
- Tables and figures: Should be included in the text or appended at the end.
- References: Should be indicated at the end of the text.

Oral presentation

Please plan for your oral presentation during the workshop a time slot of 10 minutes followed by the opportunity for discussion which should not exceed 5 minutes.
